WHEREAS prostate cancer is the most common cancer among Canadian men;

AND WHEREAS 1 in 8 Canadian men will be diagnosed with the disease in his lifetime;

AND WHEREAS every day in Canada 80 men are diagnosed with prostate cancer and 15 die from the disease;

AND WHEREAS the survival rate for prostate cancer can be close to 100% when detected early, but if detected late, 3 out of 5 men will die;

AND WHEREAS those with a family history of the disease, or those of African or Caribbean descent, are at a greater risk of developing prostate cancer;

AND WHEREAS the City of Dauphin supports Prostate Cancer Canada and all individuals committed to raising awareness about prostate cancer;
