PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS Environmental Sensitivities, including Multiple Chemical Sensitivity, can substantially limit function and significantly impact quality of life;

AND WHEREAS the Canadian Human Rights Commission recognizes Environmental Sensitivities;

AND WHEREAS it is estimated that more than one million people in Canada have been diagnosed with Multiple Chemical Sensitivity;

AND WHEREAS individuals with Multiple Chemical Sensitivity are at higher risk of experiencing Electromagnetic Hypersensitivity and vice-versa;

AND WHEREAS symptoms can range from mild to severely debilitating;

AND WHEREAS Environmental Sensitivities/Multiple Chemical Sensitivity Awareness Month is observed in May, with May 12 recognized as Environmental Sensitivities/Multiple Chemical Sensitivity Awareness Day;

AND WHEREAS to achieve a better quality of life, individuals with Environmental Sensitivities/Multiple Chemical Sensitivity require access to appropriate healthcare and safe living and working conditions;
