

## Curbside Waste & Recycling and the Residential Recycling Depot





- Must have Recycling Container set out for the City to collect the Waste Container
- Place containers out as early as the evening before collection day
  - Remove containers from the street as late as the morning following collection day
  - Only waste material is permitted in the Waste Container
- Only recyclable material is permitted in the Recycling Container
  - Between pick-ups store containers near or in a building
  - Ensure the lids are closed (prevents rodents and birds from tearing apart waste bags and spreading litter)



- Waste Containers may not be picked up if they are too heavy, the lid is up, or your Recycling Container is not out
  - Do not leave the containers on the street or the boulevard between pick-ups
  - No plastic bags in the Recycling Container
- Do not put waste material into the Recycling Container
- Do not put recyclable material into the Waste Container

## The Residential Recycling Depot - Located on 1st Ave SE (Across from the Rotary Arena)

No dumping waste, yard waste, branches, renovation debris, ashes, canned goods, broken glass, or any unacceptable non-recyclable materials. The area is under video surveillance. Improper use will result in fines.



## The Diversion Centre - Located at the Waste Disposal Site

No charge for disposal of: adhesives, aerosols, antifreeze, batteries, fluorescent lights, paint, oil, e-waste, propane, cylinders, and metal. \*\*Small fee for disposal of: fridges, freezers, and mattresses.
