## BYLAW 10/2021

## BEING A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF DAUPHIN TO AMEND ACCOMMODATION TAX BYLAW 07/2020 FOR THE PURPOSE OF IMPOSING A TAX ON ACCOMMODATION TO SUPPORT TOURISM, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, RECREATION, AND ACTIVE LIVING

WHEREAS on April 20, 2020, Council of the City of Dauphin gave Third Reading to Bylaw 07/2020 Being a Bylaw of the City of Dauphin for the Purpose of Imposing a Tax on Accommodations to Support Tourism, Economic Development, Recreation, and Active Living, with an effective date of January 1, 2021;

AND WHEREAS Bylaw 07/2020 received approval by the Minister of Finance via Order in Council No. 139/2021 dated April 21, 2021;

AND WHEREAS in correspondence dated April 28, 2021, the Minister of Finance approved Bylaw 07/2020 to "come into effect in the first month after the lifting of the provincial state of emergency currently in place due to the COVID-19 pandemic";

AND WHEREAS the provincial state of emergency referenced above expired at 4:00 p.m. on October 21, 2021;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Council of the City of Dauphin, in a meeting duly assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT Section 23 of Bylaw 07/2020 is hereby repealed;
- 2. THAT Bylaw 07/2020 is hereby amended to add the following:

This bylaw shall come into force on January 1, 2022.
